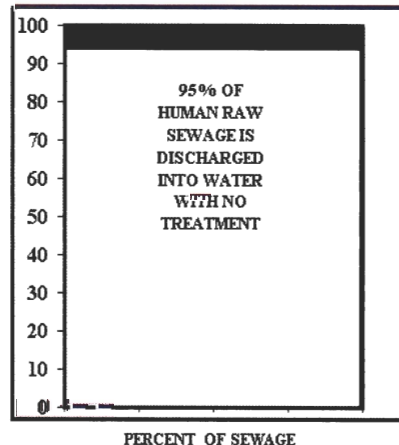
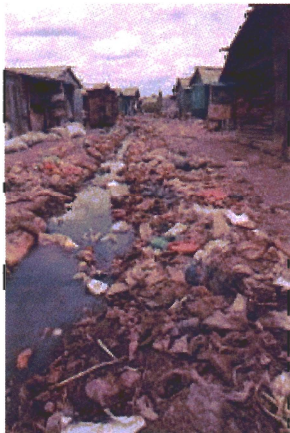
That more than 1 billion people currently lack access to clean drinking water?



A girl fills a bucket with water from a community standpipe in the town of Duckensfield, Jamaica

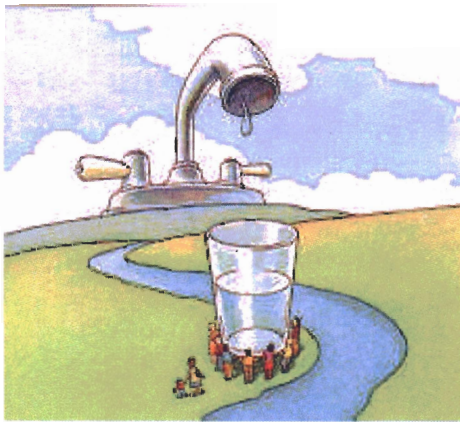


On the other hand, more than 2.5 billion people lack access to ANY kind of sanitation services!



DID YOU KNOW?

The rate that Las Vegas homeowners pay for water is \$2.27 per 1000 gallons, in San Angelo, Texas they get a portion of their water from Colorado River water even though they are not even close to that River and pay \$1.74 per 1000 gallons, and in Tucson, the rate is an unbelievably low \$1.42 per 1000 gallons. The rate that people in Easton pay is \$3.11 per 1000 gallons. In Marshfield, the rate is about \$2.60 per



1000 gallons. Obviously, water is much more plentiful in the northeastern United States than in the desert-like southwestern United States so, you and I as taxpayers pay the bill for a lot of Las Vegas' (and other dry southwestern cities') waste.....
